HOW TO START AND END THE SCHOOL DAY

HOW TO BE PREPARED FOR CLASS

- Binder with dividers.
- Notebook paper.
- Pencil pouch with pencils, pens, and a highlighter.
- Agenda book.
- Textbook or assigned materials.
- Book to read that is not your textbook.

HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH ADULTS

- Stop moving when an adult addresses you.
- Wait until the adult is done speaking before you respond.
- Respond directly to the teacher, speak in a quiet, respectful tone of voice.
- Respond with 'yes' or 'no.'
- Walk away only after the teacher has dismissed you.

HOW TO ENTER THE CLASSROOM

- Enter quietly.
- Enter prepared with materials.
- Report to seat.
- Start bell ringer/ starter/work.

HOW TO PAY ATTENTION

- Teacher will raise his or her hand.
- Freeze and stop talking.
- Keep eyes on teacher.
- Be ready for instruction.

HOW TO MOVE AS A CLASS

- Line up single file before leaving the room.
- Walk single file, quietly, and accompanied by teacher.
- Walk on the right-hand side.



HOW TO BE DISMISSED FROM CLASS

- Teacher will announce 3 to 5 minutes before dismissal.
- Clean up work area.
- Teacher will dismiss class.
